## Village of Sturtevant and RCEDC Support Grand Appliance Expansion Project

**Sturtevant, WI**—The Village of Sturtevant (The Village), in collaboration with Racine County Economic Development Corporation (RCEDC) is pleased to announce support for Grand Appliance's upcoming facility expansion in Sturtevant.

Since relocating to Sturtevant in 2017, Grand Appliance has invested in approximately 11.23 acres, generating an assessed value of \$8,040,400. The company's new expansion project includes a **48,000-square-foot addition** to its current facility, part of a larger **137,000-square-foot building**. With a total investment of **\$4.5 million**, the expansion is projected to create **15 new jobs over the next three years**, offering an average salary of **\$55,000**.

To ensure the project's success amid rising construction, labor, and material costs, Grand Appliance will receive development assistance from the Village of Sturtevant in the form of Tax Incremental Financing through TID #4. This support allows Grand Appliance to move forward with its investment while maintaining its strong presence in the community.
